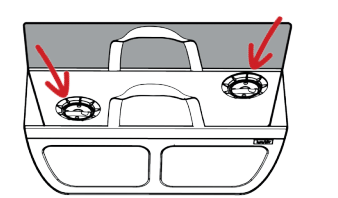


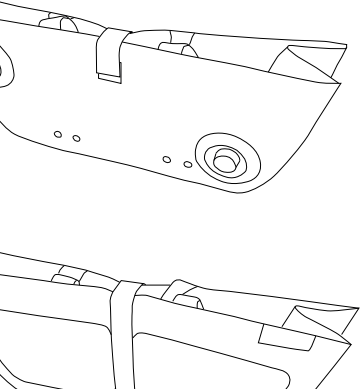
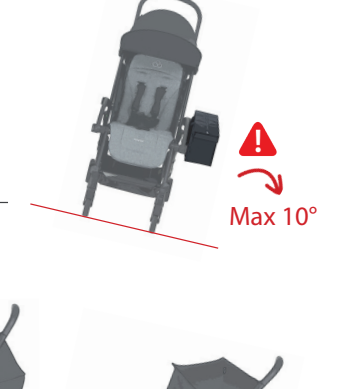
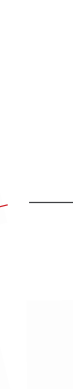
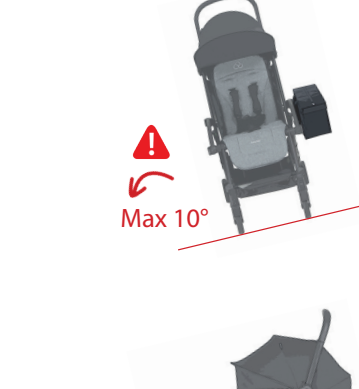
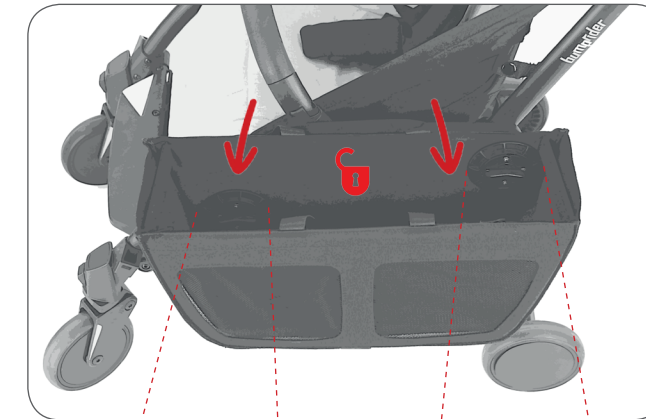
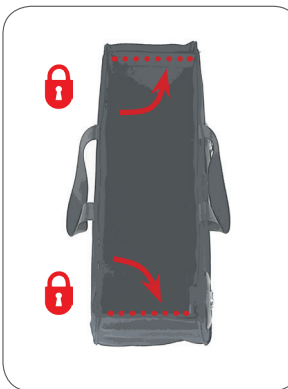
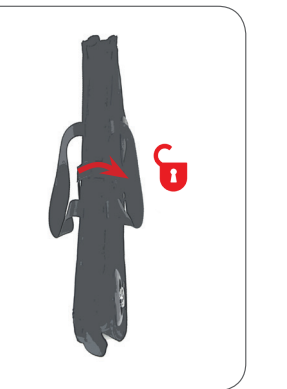
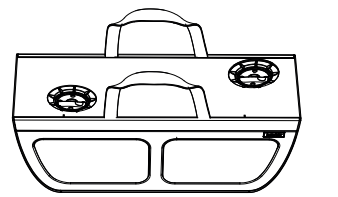
Remove packaging



1. Release sidepack from packaging by turning the outside ring in a clockwise direction until it releases.

2. Remove the back packaging board

3. Reassemble the magnetic holders to the sidepack by turning the outside ring in a counterclockwise direction.



## EN IMPORTANT

Please read these instructions carefully and keep for future reference.

## WARNING

- This product is only compatible with the Bumprider Connect and Connect2 stroller.
- Before use you must read the Connect stroller instruction manual. Safety information that is included in that manual should be applied in conjunction with this information.
- Remember that the child in the pram can access things you carry in the SidePack. Keep nothing that your child could hurt themselves with or risk swallow in the SidePack.
- Do not let your child play with this product.
- Always detach the SidePack if you park or leave the pram.
- Accessories and spare parts which have not been approved by the manufacturer cannot be used.
- Never leave your child unattended.
- Only use the SidePack on the left hand side of the chassis in direction of travel.
- This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- Never use the product if parts are missing or broken.
- Always check before using the SidePack that it is correctly mounted.
- Place small objects out of reach from the child.
- When a loaded SidePack is attached or lifted from the pram the stability is immediately affected. Be aware that the pram is risk of tipping increases when you attach or detach the SidePack from the pram.
- When attaching the SidePack to the pram, always check that there is no risk of the child being entrapped.
- Follow the instructions of the manufacturer.
- Make sure that children stay clear of moving parts if you need to adjust the SidePack.
- Keep away from fire.
- Any load attached to the pram impairs its stability. When using the SidePack never release your hands from the handle of the pram
- Avoid parking on a hill.
- Maximum weight in SidePack is 2,5 kg.
- The SidePack must be taken care of, checked and maintained on a regular basis.

- It is IMPORTANT that these instructions are understood by all people who will use the product. Always inform and instruct each person using the product, even if the person will only use it for a short while.
- The child's/children's safety is your responsibility.
- Overloading, incorrect usage of the SidePack and use of non-approved accessories may cause injury to your child/children and/or break the pram.
- Always contact your retailer to replace damaged or worn parts.
- Observe the weight and balance instructions illustrated earlier in the instruction.
- The safeguards and instructions in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions and unforeseeable situations which may occur. It must be understood that common sense, caution and care are factors which cannot be built into this product. These factors must be provided by the person(s) caring for and operating the product.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Never store your product in cold and/or damp places.
- To clean the fabrics use a brush or similar cleaning tool. Use a mild detergent and hand wash the pack and cover. Allow it to drip-dry, do not use a tumble dryer.
- Always check that you have refitted the parts correctly in accordance with the instructions in the handbook after washing or maintenance.
- Regularly clean SidePack rear connecting points.
- Lack of maintenance could cause corrosion and or malfunction.
- Be careful during transportation and storage of the product as the surface of the Sidepack is fragile. Scratches that arise after sale are not a justifiable complaint.
- Regularly check that all carrying straps and the bottom of the product is not damaged or worn.
- Get in touch with your authorised Bumprider retailer immediately to replace a damaged or worn part with a new part.
- Keep maintenance and using according to these instructions at all times.
